

Approaching the chalet, you're greeted by its traditional stone façade. Step through the front door and the interior offers a welcoming blend of warmth and simplicity. Exposed wooden beams overhead, adorned by traditional cow bells create an inviting atmosphere, with the wood-burning fireplace, cozy furnishings and Savoyard décor inviting you to unwind in this unique mountain haven.

This chalet is fully connected to the local electricity grid and boasts a surface area of over 100m2 on two levels.

The kitchen, though modest, carries the charm of a classic mountain retreat. The dining area takes centre stage here, offering the perfect spot to share stories and laughter over a home-cooked mountain feast.

The snug twin beds feature in this open plan setup, each enveloped by curtains with wooden accents and traditional textile, inviting restful nights after exhilarating days on the nearby slopes.

This floor has around 53m2 of living space and two storage areas of around 16m2.

On the way down, you'll find a comfortable dormitory-style area of around 47m2 with 8 extra beds, a toilet and a rustic shower room. Traditionally, this is where the cows were housed, and this space has been designed with this heritage in mind.

Step outside to take in the incredible panoramic views of the surrounding mountains.

A wood storage area is also outside the chalet.
