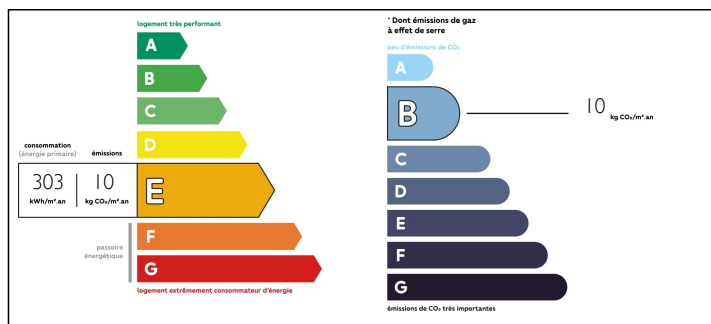

## DESCRIPTION

Set over four levels, the property is in good condition throughout, but there is also a superb opportunity to put your own stamp on this lovely mid-20th-century townhouse for a modest investment.

The property was upgraded twelve years ago, including works to the roof, windows and bathrooms. More recently, the walls have been whitewashed throughout and the flooring replaced in the bathrooms. There is a mix of underfloor heating and electric radiators.

Samoëns provides access to France's fourth largest ski area, the Grand Massif (which includes Flaine, Les Carroz, Morillon and Sixt-fer-a-Cheval) and it's 265km of snow-sure pistes. As Geneva airport is just one hour away by car, the house has excellent rental potential as well as making a lovely primary or secondary residence.

Samoëns is much more than just a ski resort however. Steeped in history, Samoëns is a beautiful traditional village which dates back to the 12th century and retains many of its historic buildings and landmarks.

The Giffre Valley as a whole is just as popular from late spring through to early autumn with activities for all ages, including fabulous hiking opportunities, outdoor swimming pools and lakes, paragliding, rafting, cycling, canyoning and so much more.
