




IN BRIEF

DESCRIPTION

Entering from the quiet village square, into a gravelled courtyard there is access directly to the ground floor and, via steps to the first floor. These comprise linked apartments which can be used separately or together. Entering the ground floor into a bright hallway (8m2) there is access to an ensuite bedroom (16m2)with doors opening onto the gardens also from this hall you enter into the beautiful living room (28m2) with high cathedral. ceilings, an antique style stove and lots of light. This opens to the dining room, (21m2) with 3m double doors into the pool garden.. There is a spacious fully equipped modern kitchen. At this level is a further bedroom (14m2) with bathroom, again with doors to the gardens.

From the living room stairs climb to the first floor where there is a good size living room (27m2), a kitchen, a bathroom and two bedrooms (11, 14m2). There is a log burning fire and access to a large terrace (35m) with vine covered pergola and enjoying fabulous views over the countryside and hills.

Outside, the gardens are easy to manage with gravelled courtyards, specimen trees and plants and an attractive and safely fenced pool. A stone...
