

A rare C17th/18th stone riverside house with a lovely garden, courtyard, old bread oven and guest cottage



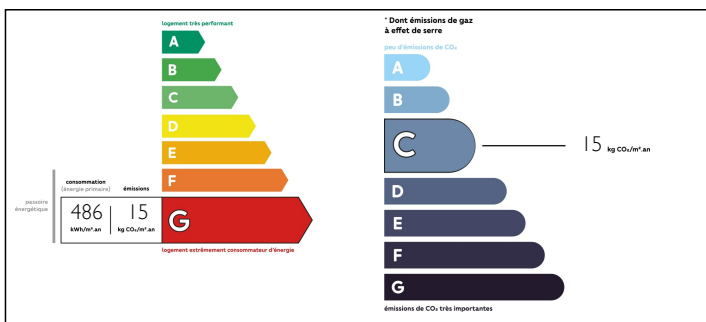

IN BRIEF

Perched high on a ridge virtually overhanging the Auvézère river and well above the flood level is this superb stone period property. Its upper windows and terrace overlook the river and a vista across the fields and valley, and there is a paved path that descends closer to the water's edge and a 2nd wooden terrace, the only aspect that needs repair. The house has stone bread oven and garden to one side and a courtyard and with a stone single bedroomed guest cottage the other. The house and cottage have been beautifully restored with the best materials and appliances and well maintained with pretty period features, and there is the possibility in the main house to make the current library into a 3rd bedroom. The property is in a tiny linear hamlet along the river of no more than 4 or 5 dwellings that in outline has remained unchanged...

Ground floor

Kitchen with stone fireplace with wood burner, exposed ceiling beams, floor, French door onto riverside terrace 24 m²

Utility room with water heater and water softener 6 m²

W/c tiled and decorated 2 m²

Washroom with walk in tiled shower and marble washbasin 4 m²

Sitting room panelled with 17th/18th century carved wooden fire surround and insert, exposed ceiling beams, floor tiles and French door opening onto riverside terrace 23,5 m²

Library (that could be a 3rd bedroom), floor tiles, window facing river, 15 m²

1st floor

1st Bedroom with dormer window facing river and view, wooden flooring 11 m²

Corridor with wardrobe wooden flooring 8 m²

Bathroom with bath and washbasin each high standard hardwood surrounds, dormer window overlooking river and view 4 m²

W/c with fitted cupboard 2 m²

2nd bedroom with dormer window facing river and view, wooden flooring, painted roof beams 12 m²
