

DESCRIPTION

This property has undergone many changes over the years and offers various options to the next owner. You could either use the main house as one large house or use part of the house as your living space and part as a Gite or Apartment. There is also the separate house which could be rented out or kept for when family and friends visit.

The property is situation on the edge of the village and within walking distance to the centre. When you arrive at the property you enter via the front door into a an entrance hall which then leads through to the dining room (29.65m2). This room over looks the back garden and is nice and bright and airy with a large window and glaszed double doors.

To the right is the sitting room / lounge (54m2) which again is a nice bright room and has windows to 2 sides. There is a large ornate fireplace. To the corner is access to the turret. This can then be accessed on the 1st floor and from the attic.

The kitchen is situated after the dining room and could do with being refreshed in preparation for all the cooking and entertaining that could be done in this house. Again this over looks the back of the house.

Underneath you will find a vaulted cellar and the oil fuelled central heating boiler.
