

So let's get started. In the centre of the village, tucked away behind its surrounding walls, its wrought iron gates and its large pillars, it appears before our astonished eyes! This building is incredible and imposing! Push open the massive front door and you're speechless! You know that incredible feeling that just makes you say 'wow' in a familiar way deep down inside !

A luxurious, sparkling hall where every architectural detail has been sublimated, as indeed everywhere in the house, sets the tone! Everything is magnificent from floor to ceiling, with no exaggeration whatsoever. Floors, mouldings, frames, chandeliers, style....

This vast hall leads first to a bright, cosy study, then to a first living room that is absolutely divine, with its herringbone parquet flooring, ornate doors and sparkling colours. A second lounge on the south side is an incredible room with a custom-built, energy-efficient fireplace.
