

Let's start our visit by taking the little path around the bend in the main road, where it gradually reveals itself like a fortress.

You will be immediately captivated by its location and the surrounding meadow, which enhances the overall appearance of the buildings. It should be noted that the owners have worked hard to enhance the property, transforming the surrounding woods into an open landscaped area.

A pretty stone porch adjoining the double garage and the beautiful outbuildings welcomes us and leads us to the dwelling, where you will be pleasantly surprised by the shape of the buildings, comprising the main farmhouse and its elegant extension.

Naturally, you'll be charmed by the authentic look of the stone walls and the large number of traditional windows with their small panes, all of which have been deliberately preserved here. We first enter an entrance hall that leads to a masterly living room with cement tiles on the floor, a French-style ceiling, a monumental fireplace and exposed stone walls. Time has stood still here, and a monastery table sets the scene!

An equally remarkable side lounge/library with the same symmetrical fireplace extends this living area. Both rooms have direct access to the terrace at the front.
