

DESCRIPTION

Enter the property to a spacious hallway 20.6m² with access to a grand sitting room 41m² which has duel aspect french doors on to 2 of the outdoor terraces and a fireplace with log burner at one end. Opposite the sitting room is a dining kitchen 25m² with a range of modern fitted units and french doors on to the front terrace. Behind the kitchen is the boiler room 6m² which houses a fuel boiler. Midway through the entrance hall is a staircase leading to the first floor. Behind the sitting room is a room currently used as a tv/reading room 13m² but could easily convert to a ground floor bedroom as it faces the ground floor shower room 7.10m² with separate WC 2m².

To the first floor are 5 double bedrooms. Bedroom I $9m^2$ has duel aspect windows, bedroom $2~16m^2$ has fitted wardrobes, bedroom $3~16m^2$, Bedroom $4~17.5m^2$ and bedroom $5~11.5m^2$. There are bathrooms at either end of the landing $5m^2$ & $4m^2$ and a separate WC $3m^2$.

Outside there is a large barn in good order with 4 seperate chambers measuring 380m² in total. The property has its own access road and enjoys panoramic views all around.
