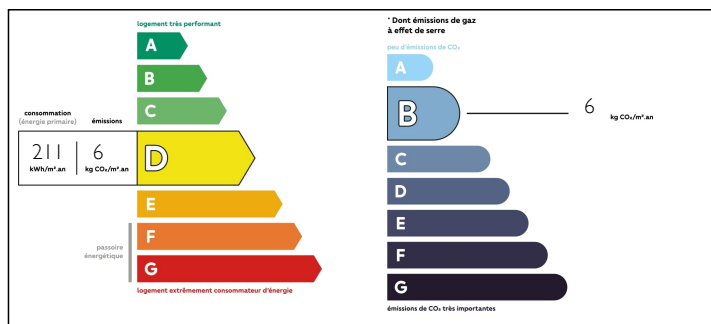

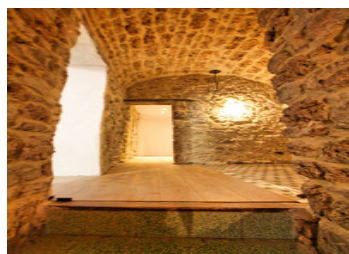

DESCRIPTION

The house comprises at street level an entrance hall (13,5m²) leading into a kitchen (11m²), 2 stone vaulted rooms (20 and 15m²) with double doors onto the street and a shower room and separate wc to the rear. This space could be ideal as a shop, with the necessary permissions, or perhaps as independent accommodation.

An impressive exposed stone staircase leads to the second floor where there are 2 good sized bedrooms (20 and 22m²), both with beautiful exposed stone walls and floating wooden flooring. One of the bedrooms has an ensuite bathroom (to be completed). Also on this floor a hallway with separate wc.

On the 2nd floor is a superb open plan living space with corner kitchen (60m²) and a wood burning stove. Glass doors open onto a terrace (9m²) with views over the trees and gardens of the Abbey.

This unusual charming property has spacious living accommodation with well proportioned rooms packed with original character features. It is in excellent condition and the rooms can be arranged to suit your needs. There is also the possibility to purchase a garden of 280m² just a couple of minutes from the house, in an elevated position overlooking the village.

Saint Guilhem-le-Desert nestles in the heart of the Languedoc countryside and the Gorges d'Herault and is just a couple of kilometres from the Pont du Diable, both classified as UNESCO World Heritage sites by virtue of their being on the pilgrimage route to Santiago de Compostela. Developed...
