

## DESCRIPTION

Formerly an old school house dating between 1866 and 1868, with some of the original features from its school days including the boys and girls exercise barns called a préau The house has a descent sized open plan kitchen / dining room (30.36m²), leading into a large salon (52.62m<sup>2</sup>) with long double aspect windows giving the house a bright and airy feel and a wood burning stove. The dining area with staircase leads into a downstairs bedroom (19.15m<sup>2</sup>). Upstairs a landing leads to two bedrooms (20.39m<sup>2</sup> and (20.33m2), one of which has far reaching views and a bathroom with bath, two wash basins and a WC. The garage (15m<sup>2</sup>) is attached to the side of the house. To the rear of the house is the courtyard which would have been once a playground, some of the markings on the wall suggest a number of children's games. To the end of the courtyard are the préau (21.76m2) and four small store rooms with open barn (17.20m2), one of which could be knocked through so as to create a pathway to the potager and garden behind the buildings. There is no fixed heating only Wood burning stove. Partially double glazed. The current owners started to do renovations, but have not been able to complete so there is a lot of areas that will need full renovation including the roof.
