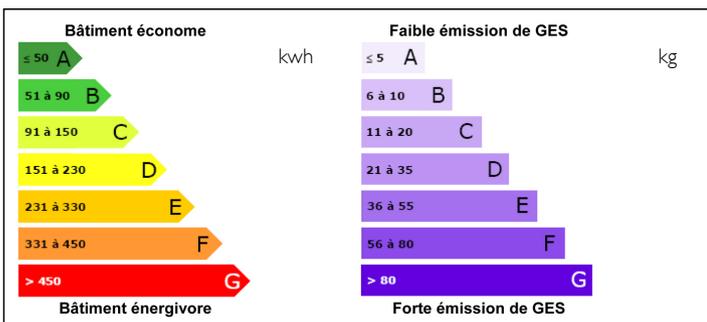

DESCRIPTION

Entering through a vestibule, the ground floor provides a large retail space. To the rear of this room, behind partition doors, there is space for a laundry and a separate shower room.

On the first floor, there is a bright spacious living room, fitted kitchen with skylight above and a WC. On the second floor, there are two good sized bedrooms and a WC, which could be easily converted to provide a shower room. Stairs lead to a large, fully boarded attic space with skylight window above, which could provide a third bedroom.
