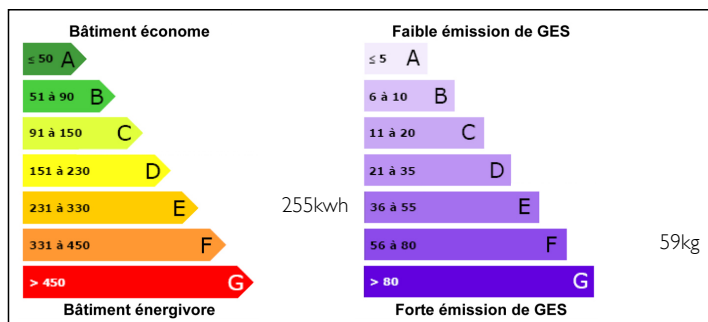

DESCRIPTION

Ground floor : large living room/dining room with original fireplace and wood-burner; kitchen with range of units, sink and cooker; shower room with washbasin, WC and plumbing for washing machine.

First floor : large landing; bedroom 1 with exposed beams and en suite bathroom with shower, washbasin, WC and heated towel rail.

Basement : bedrooms 2 and 3, and hallway leading to the garden.

There are two vaulted cellars - one is accessible from the back garden and one from the front of the house.
