

# DESCRIPTION

#### Ground floor:

Entrance directly into the kitchen/dining room 33.4m². Fashionable cement tiled floors, fitted country style kitchen, access to front and rear garden, large fireplace.

Door to living room  $47.5 \text{m}^2$  - beautiful wooden floor, stone walls and exposed ceiling beams, French doors to the front.

Store room 22.2m<sup>2</sup> with potential to become another living area with shower room and bedroom above.

#### First floor:

From the living room, wooden stairs lead up to the landing area with access to all other rooms.

Bedroom 16.1 m<sup>2</sup> (26 m<sup>2</sup> into the eaves). Ceiling beams, stone gable end, velux windows to front and velux to rear.

Bedroom 12.2m<sup>2</sup> (20m<sup>2</sup> into the eaves). Ceiling beams, stone gable end, velux to rear and window to front.

Bathroom 7m<sup>2</sup> comprising bath, walk in shower, wc and basin.

Outside the courtyard to the front houses a workshop and garden to the side and rear of the house where the stunning stone bread oven can be found.

The house is in a hamlet and about 2km from the nearby village with local shop and bread drop and bar/restaurant.
