

This lovely little house opens onto a large living room with a separate kitchen and bathroom on the ground floor. A utility room leads from the kitchen into a small, south facing garden. The entire first floor consists of one very spacious bedroom with original features. The house needs completely renovating but has fantastic potential.

The village has all amenities, including two bars, a supermarket, two bakeries, and a handful of local shops. The house is within easy walking distance of the river Sartre with lovely riverside walks and a large communal park.
