

DESCRIPTION

Situated on the flanks of the famous Mont Ventoux, at the edge of a vast forested plateau, lies the beautiful perched village of Sault, which is perhaps best known for its lavender. The blue and purple fields, alternated with golden wheat, seem to surround the village with a beautiful patchwork which stretches out to the horizon.

Set at an altitude of nearly 800m, Sault offers a great variety of activities for lovers of the outdoors: one of the 3 starting points for the ascent of Mont Ventoux, it has long been a draw for cyclists, but also offers equestrian trails and great hiking. The village itself is lively with many little restaurants and shops, and a vibrant art scene.
