

DESCRIPTION

This house is located in a small quiet hamlet. Double gates open off the lane and lead onto a gravel drive which extends round to the rear of the house, with plenty of private parking and a useful timber outbuilding with light & power connected. Deep borders on either side of the driveway are filled with attractive flowering shrubs.

The house has chestnut flooring and double glazed windows.

The front door opens into a hallway with a cupboard and door accessing the cellar. A staircase rises from the hallway to a first floor landing off which is a double bedroom (16m2) with a corner fireplace.

The staircase then rises to the second floor where there is a further double bedroom (16.5m2) and a door to the attic space, which has a fully boarded floor and could be converted to provide another bedroom if required. Double doors access a very pleasant balcony which overlooks the rear garden. To the left is an inner hallway which has access to the shower room with basin and w.c. and another door to a second w.c. with basin.

Further to the left of the inner hallway is access to the kitchen /dining space (22.5m2) A large room with vaulted ceiling and velux window.

The dining space is very light with French doors to the front and rear gardens, and the kitchen, which has fitted cupboards and worktops, also overlooks the rear garden.
