

DESCRIPTION

The house opens onto a good sized living room with a fireplace, leading to an equipped kitchen and a bedroom. A small shower room is also on the ground floor. Although in need of renovation, the house is habitable allowing for work to be carried out little by little. Upstairs there is a good sized attic which could be converted to provide additional living space. Outside there is a garden shelter that the current owners use for storage but that could be used as a studio or workspace. There is also a good sized cellar under the house providing additional storage space.

This is a great opportunity to acquire a period property with a private garden at a realistic price. Fully converted it would make a charming home or rental property or a lovely lock up and leave French holiday home.
