

### DESCRIPTION

Bright house with double glazing.

On the main floor - a kitchen of 15 m<sup>2</sup> to renovate, a conservatory with shower room and toilet. Living room, spacious dining room of 33 m<sup>2</sup>, with fireplace. Main entrance hall. 2 bedrooms of 16 m<sup>2</sup>. Wc.

On the first floor: a bedroom of  $16 \text{ m}^2$  with nice view on the valley and 2 attics of about  $30 \text{ m}^2$  suitable for conversion.

Built on a garden level basement of 118 m<sup>2</sup>, including a hallway, garage 2 places, oil boiler, wine cellar.

Roof and insulation, redone in 1990.

Mains drainage.

Some work to be done to create a bathroom on the first floor.

Near shops. Motorway access 4 km.

Planted in the 1930s, this home borrows its hybrid style from multiple eras, drawing inspiration from the picturesque movement of the late 191. Designed to surprise, it is imagined as a painting set in the middle of the garden, overlooking the Isle Valley.
