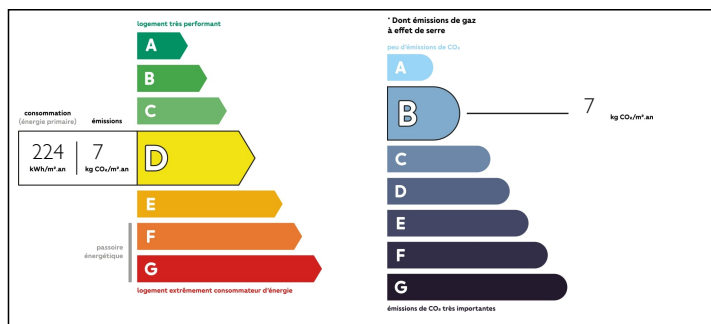

IN BRIEF

On the heights of Roquebrun is this extraordinary 3-bedroom house with its roots in medieval times. Roquebrun is a beautiful hanging village on the edge of the Haut Languedoc Natural Park. The village with its orange-tree-lined main street overlooks the Orb river and is treasured for its beauty, excellent wines and localised micro-climate, the hilltop Mediterranean garden and the gorgeous walks and biking trails up into the hills. There is also a kayak rental base here, along with many other activities. Restaurants and bistros, the grocery store, the boulangerie serving coffees overlooking the river - this is a unique and peaceful spot. 45 minutes from the white sandy beaches of the Mediterranean, 35 minutes from Béziers and its international airport. Roquebrun also has its own riverside pebble beach, and a public river-pool freely accessible for bathing.

Leaving your car in your private parking space, the view from here is striking as you walk down the steps into the terraced garden with mature trees.

Entering the house through the ancient timber front door, you have the galley kitchen in front of you and the main reception room to your right, with a traditional Languedoc fireplace with wood-burning stove. There is also a second door that leads into the garden. The views here are lovely and become even more striking as you climb to the first and second floors.

On the first floor there are two bedrooms and a family bathroom with a hip-bath/shower.

On the second floor, with direct separate access down stone steps into the terraced garden, is the master suite with a corner shower/washroom and a walk-in wardrobe. The views over the river valley and the multi-arched bridge are truly exceptional from here.

Walk outside, and you are in your terraced private garden, with a vine-covered, south-facing summer kitchen and with ancient ruins and cellars. This is an old-stone lover's dream and potentially, under close adult supervision of course, a child's dream "mystery playground".

If you are looking for an historical stone building with an updated interior, this is for you. If you are looking for a character property with terra-cotta floor tiles, exposed beams and exposed stone features, then this haven is for you.
