

DESCRIPTION

The whole of the ground floor has terracotta style floor tiling.

The front door, flanked by a climbing rose bush, gives access to a lobby from this delightful street, leading into the south-west facing living area of $2 \, \text{Im}^2$, with exposed timber beams, a shelf alcove and a lovely ambiance.

A wide passage has storage areas, including one made from a former wine vat. The dining/kitchen of I4m² has a window out to a courtyard, again exposed beams and alcoves, and unfitted kitchen units with light green and white tiling.

Stairs lead up to the first floor where there is a very light, large bedroom of $22m^2$ with exposed beams. There is a second bedroom of $11m^2$ with timber floorboards, and a spacious, very light, shower room of $6.6m^2$. A second stair in terracotta and wood leads up past a large storage shelf to a living area, study or bedroom of almost $10m^2$, with exposed beams, exposed stone and large glazed doors, to a $9m^2$ terrace.

The house has electric heating.

There is an épicerie/cafe and restaurant/snack bar in the village; the cave of the château now opens as a wine bar and has art exhibitions.

The village is 17 km from Narbonne, 36 km from Béziers, 42 km from Carcassonne, 35 km from the sea, 5 km from Ginestas, 9km from Lézignan and 11km from Olonzac, and 115 km from Spain (an hour and a quarter).
