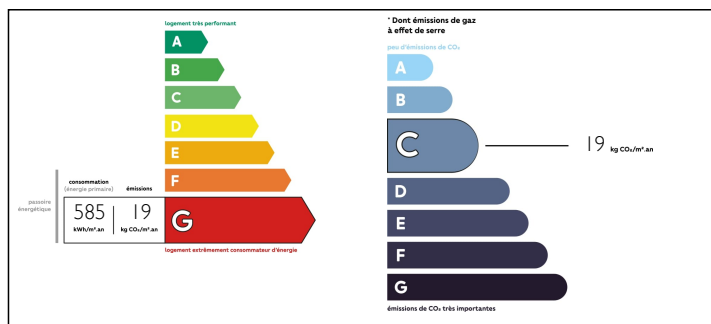

Attractive 2 bed cottage set in landscaped gardens in quiet hamlet, with garden studio, garage, covered dining area, sun terrace and workshop. The property is situated in a small hamlet, less than a kilometre from the village of Genneteil. 13km and 14km respectively from market towns Le Lude and Baugé, each with their châteaux, shops, restaurants, supermarkets, and 17 km from La Flèche, the tourism centre of La Sarthe with its renown zoo and military academy. Baugé also boasts the areas most beautiful 18 hole golf course.. Easy access to Normandie and Brittany ferry ports, 62 km to (Tours with international airport, with regular flights throughout the year to London Stansted), 55km to Angers, 60km to Le Mans - all with TGV stations linked to Paris and the rest of France.

DESCRIPTION

Cottage in good condition, with the roof and most of the windows replaced and the exterior and shutters repainted. Plenty of character, with terracotta tiles, exposed beams, large fireplace. Heated via log burner and electric radiators. New water heater and extractor fan. Fibre broadband available. Septic tank functions, but will require replacing as deemed too small.
