

DESCRIPTION

Nestling close to the nave of the beautiful and historic village church, the house has two entrances: from the street side and the garden.

From lower ground floor (street side) there is a secure entrance with large garage (23) with automatic doors and an entrance hall (17 m²). There is plenty of space here and could be a garage and a workshop.

On the ground level floor there is a recently fitted kitchen (10m²) and bright open plan living room/dining room (56 m²) with a large wood-burning stove.

From here there is easy access to the covered terrace and garden, which is fully fenced and has a wood shed (10m²) suitable for storing garden equipment.

There is also a bathroom with shower (4m²)

On the first floor, are three bedrooms with storage space and lovely views over the river valley and the neighbouring department of the Gers.

Bedroom 1: The large master bedroom has plenty of storage space with south facing views (28.5 m²) and automatic blinds

Bedroom 2: This is also south facing (12m²) with automatic blinds.

Bedroom 3: This is currently configured as an office space (m²)

There is also a separate WC on this floor.
