




IN BRIEF

DESCRIPTION

Set back from a quiet road, a driveway leads to this simple stone built house.

On entering these is a bright kitchen/dining room (24m2) leading to a living room (18m2) with wood burning stove and doors to the garden.

On this floor there is a first bedroom (11 m2) and bathroom with shower and separate WC.

Wooden stairs lead to the second bedroom (19m2), a study (7m2) and a dressing room. One of these rooms could easily become the third bedroom.

Outside there is a garage and several outbuildings.

The land, which is partly constructible, is well maintained with a vegetable garden, an orchard, meadow and a forested area to the rear of the property.

Location and Infrastructure:

Fourcès is situated in the northern Gers, on the borders of Lot-et-Garonne, and in ancient province of Gascony.

This medieval bastide village (a 13th century clock tower still remains) is officially recognised as one of the most beautiful in France. 'Les Plus Beaux Villages de France' is an independent association created in 1982 for the promotion of small rural villages with a rich cultural heritage. There are currently only 172 villages that merit this much-coveted accolade.

And for a village of less than 300 inhabitants the social calendar is also remarkably full. There are arts and crafts galleries, boutiques, and antique shops throughout. And every year, in the last weekend of April, there is held the spectacular and internationally renowned flower festival.
