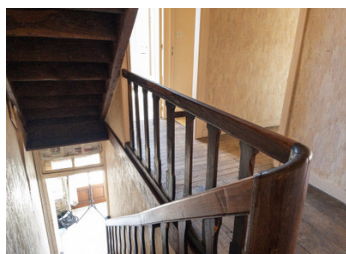

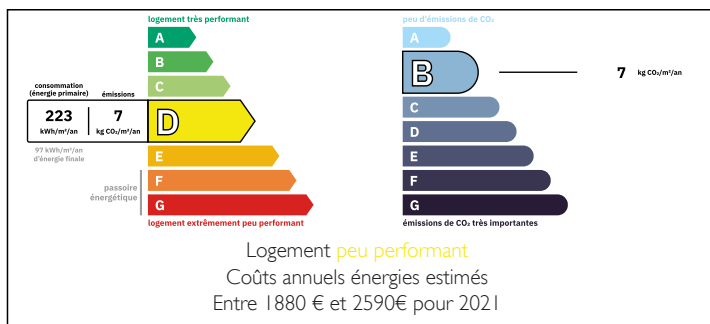

This attractive stone building offers plenty of options.

The apartment covers the whole of the first floor, is currently let out and is in good condition throughout. The tenants will leave when the property is sold. There are 4 bedrooms, 2 shower rooms and a lovely open plan kitchen/dining room and lounge. Well insulated, double glazed, heated via modern electric radiators and connected to mains drains, this part of the property is immediately and comfortably habitable.

On the ground floor, work has started on a 2nd lounge with a small but pretty courtyard, at the front of the property.

Also on the ground floor you have the shop space, the laboratory (or 1st kitchen area), cold store, kitchen and the huge bakery space which still houses the commercial bread ovens - a huge room that does need modernisation. Or, of course, the whole space could be converted for a new project or into habitable space. There is a courtyard at the rear.

The property also has a separate barn for parking and storage.

So, a project, certainly, but the asking price more than reflects the works required and the apartment offers lovely living accommodation or potential rental income from day one.
