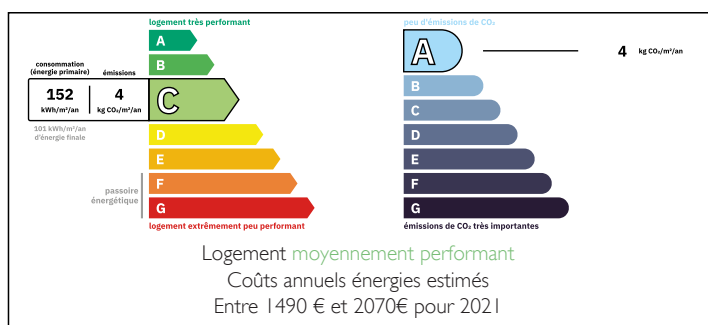

DESCRIPTION

This beautiful 185 m2 family home was built in 1980 and has been very well looked after. It is located in a lovely, quiet area with stunning views on a no-through road with the Dordogne river and local town both within walking distance.

The ground floor consists of :

An open plan living room/dining room (31 m2) with tiled floor and a lovely wood burning Norwegian stove in the fireplace which diffuses heat around the rest of the house with two double windows and doors leading onto the surrounding terrace.

A kitchen (11,5 m2) with fitted units and tiled floor which leads directly into a lovely, bright, enclosed conservatory (18 m2) also with tiled flooring, which can be used as a dining room or extra living space, and opens out onto the garden.

Three light, airy bedrooms (10,5 m2, 10,5 m2 and 12,5 m2), 1 of which includes a fitted wardrobe, all with laminate, wooden flooring and double windows, 2 of which have beautiful views of the surroundings.

A laundry room (5,5 m2) which houses the gas central heating boiler and electric board with room for a washing machine, dryer and freezer, with double doors leading to the side terrace.

A large bath/shower room (7 m2) and separate WC.

The first floor(parquet flooring) consists of :

A large, tiled hallway.

Two large double bedrooms (16 m2 and 18 m2), one with fitted wardrobe, both with lovely wooden floors and double windows one of which has stunning views of the surrounding countryside.
