IN BRIEF

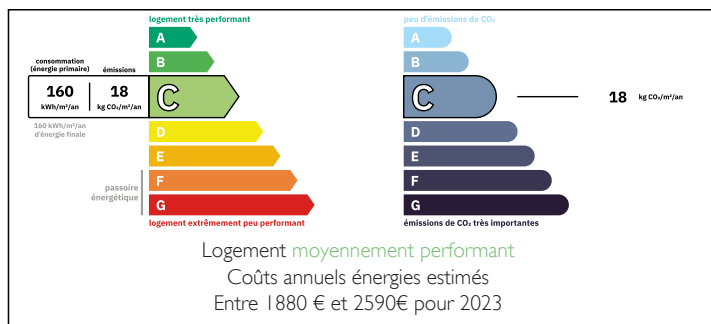
Charming stone farmhouse thoughtfully renovated into three independent properties, each with its own private entrance and garden, set in 1,350m² of land, surrounded by beautiful countryside. Located just outside the popular medieval town of Gourdon and close to the Dordogne River.

The two main gîtes (125m² and 118m²) offer spacious, bright accommodation. On the ground floor, both feature large open-plan kitchen/dining areas opening onto private terraces with BBQ areas and enclosed gardens, along with a separate living room and bathroom. Upstairs are four generous bedrooms and a second bathroom. Finished to a high standard, these modern gîtes are currently rented year-round, providing an excellent rental income.

The third stone property, with its own entrance, is a cosy 59m² one-bedroom gîte, offering a kitchen,

Each dwelling benefits from its own private entrance and enclosed garden, making it equally suitable for rental activity, multi-generational living or a combination of home and income.
