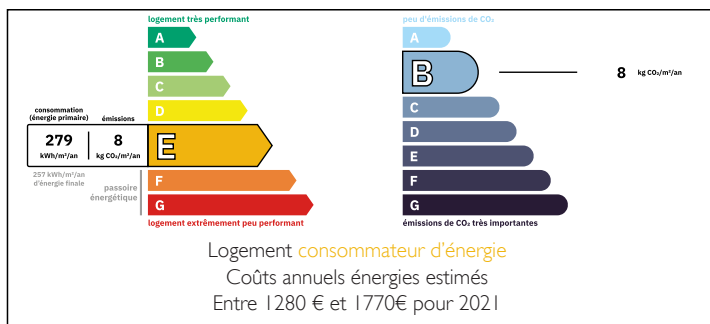


Charming Historic Stone House in the Heart of a Medieval Village, with Terrace and Workshop

The main living accommodation is on the upper level, enjoying natural light and village views. It offers a bright living room with a wood-burning insert, a kitchen with an access to the exterior, a shower room and WC. Upstairs, a cozy landing leads to three bedrooms with charming solid wood floors and another WC.

A terrace and small garden are accessed externally, with potential to add a metal staircase for direct access. Adjacent is a large garage, offering excellent potential for conversion into extra living space.
