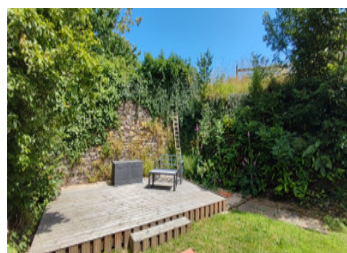

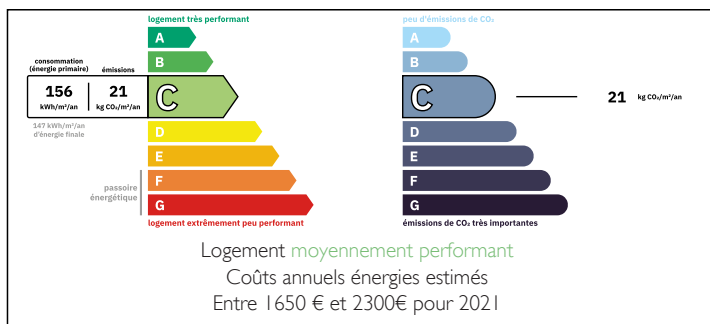

Arriving at the property, two entrances welcome you from the front patio and parking area. The main entrance hall sets the tone, leading gracefully to the elegant dining and living rooms on one side, and to the beautifully appointed kitchen and a utility room and further on to the shaded summer room on the other. A full ground-floor bathroom lies at the end of the entrance hall, while the sweeping staircase carries you to the first floor.

The second entrance brings you into the practical boot room and laundry, before opening onto the cooler summer room and the fully fitted kitchen. Here, a delightful surprise awaits: a hidden rear pantry and a clever instant boiling water tap for ease and style. Makes a great cuppa....

The dining and living rooms are truly generous, the living area boasting an impressive hearth with log burner, and triple-aspect windows framing captivating countryside views. The dining room offers a convivial space with built in bar. Upstairs, four spacious bedrooms and two bathrooms (each with WC) provide comfort and space.
