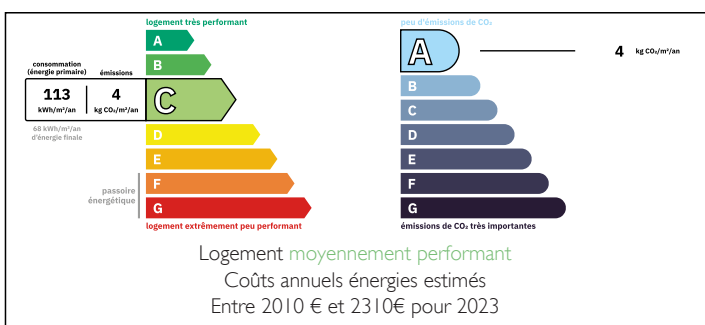

IN BRIEF

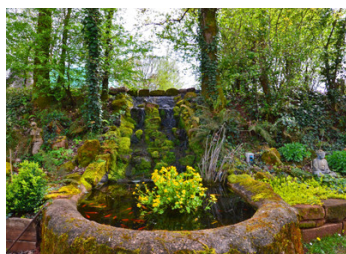
Well secluded and in a commanding position, this farmhouse has been beautifully renovated interiorly and has a charming array of ancient farm buildings around an open courtyard with neat lawns to one side and steps up to a fenced pool and a shaded sitting area. The house consists of a sitting room with a stone fireplace and French doors that open onto a terrace facing the evening sunsets in the west and there is a sunroom with a bar overlooking the courtyard. The kitchen has been refurbished with high quality tiling and fitments that have a neat country feel and the bathrooms are modern and well equipped to serve two ground floor bedrooms, and a large one upstairs with good head height under an impressive roof structure. This is perfect for those seeking a country home or retreat...

The house (double glazed throughout and has an economical heat/air conditioning pump system)

Ground floor

Large sitting room with stone fireplace, exposed ceiling beams, French doors, floor tiling (Travertin) 32,5 m²

Kitchen fully fitted with tiled floor (Travertin) 23 m²

Larder 3 m²

Utility room with back door access 9 m²

Large covered sunroom overlooking farm buildings and courtyard, bar and seating area 32 m²

1st bedroom with a view 14 m²

Washroom fully fitted and tiled with shower, washbasin and w/c 5 m²

2nd bedroom 14 m²

1st floor (hardwood flooring throughout)

3rd bedroom with exposed roof structure and 4 dormer windows 27 m² (38 m² floor area)
