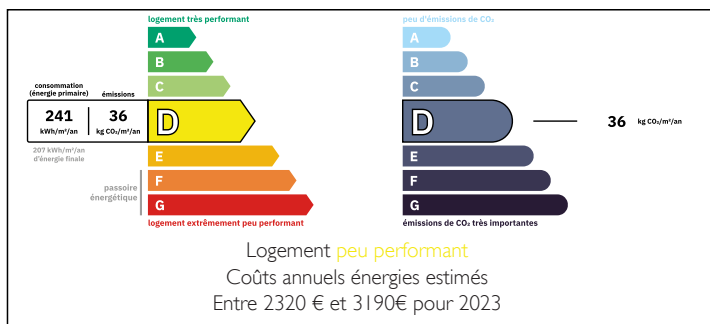


IN BRIEF

DESCRIPTION

You enter the property into a small hallway. To the left is a spacious living room with a corner kitchen, dining area, and lounge, featuring a large log-burning stove. To the right, you'll find a WC, followed by a shower room, and then the first bedroom.

Upstairs, there are two additional bedrooms, one leading through to the other, and a storage room that houses the gas central heating condensing boiler.

Outside, you'll discover a beautifully landscaped garden filled with a variety of plants, shrubs, and fruit trees. The property also includes an in-ground salt water swimming pool with a new liner (2020) and cover, heated by solar panels.

LOCAL TAXES

A separate building on the property contains a garage, workshop, and a small studio. Additionally, there is a very large barn, ideal for housing a motorhome or cars, or even for conversion into several gites, subject to planning permission.

The village is surrounded by picturesque countryside typical of the Dordogne, featuring rolling hills, dense forests, and river valleys..
