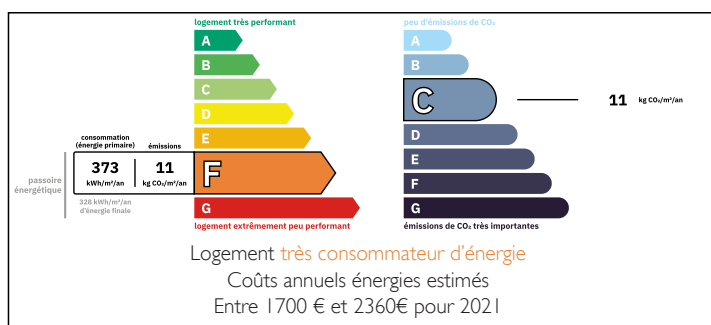

DESCRIPTION

The nearby town of Palluau-sur-Indre sits on a hill topped by a private chateau. Some facilities in the village including a depot de pain, cafe bar/tabac, post office and a few more. Supermarkets, restaurants and more commerce can be found in Chatillon-sur-Indre and Buzancais.

The whole house has a light and airy feel with plenty of space. This is a gorgeous place to rest awhile with the house, the view and the tranquility that you will find here.

• Ground Floor.

Three of the ground floor rooms have doors opening onto the front of the property towards the view. The kitchen (18m²) is big enough for a table and chairs as well as the basic essentials for cooking. To the right of the kitchen, the living room (26m²) has a further dining table, sofas and a glass-fronted wood burning stove. Next to the living room is a large room (34m²) to renovate with double-glazed doors opening out to the front of the property. Stairs from this room lead to the upper floor.

To the left of the kitchen is a lobby with small shower (2m²) with wc (4.7m²) and then a delightful dual aspect light and airy bedroom (12.4m²) looking out across the amazing views. This is the owners favourite spot to sit and ponder awhile. Double-glazed doors open out to the front.

There is a further space within the house perimeter which was probably a garage or animal feed store but could be included into the house...
