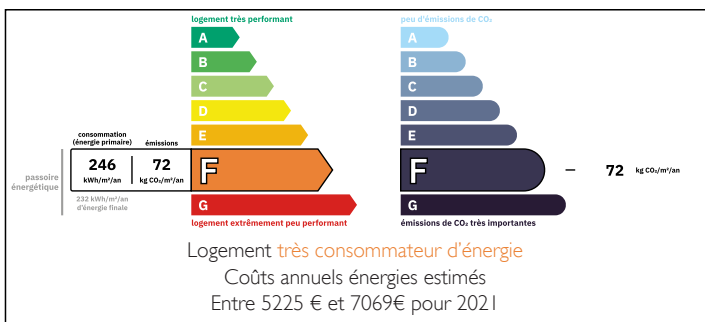

For sale furnished if desired. Combine some of the lovely old pieces with your own, redecorate and create a stunning home in this building that oozes history and charm.

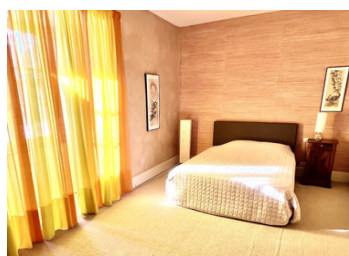
If you are searching for a bed and breakfast property, the three existing bathrooms for the five large bedrooms are a good start. Adding more is possible.

DESCRIPTION

From the road, enter the front garden through the iron gate. Ancient wisteria arbour shading living room windows. Pass through the front door into the very generous entrance hall, vaulted plaster ceilings, flagstone floor.

To the right: airy reception room with wood-burning stove, built-in cupboard and access to the circular tower. Windows to front.

To the left: spacious living room with open fireplace, Windows to front. Door communicating with kitchen:

Fully fitted kitchen with solid wood doors. Large dining area. Windows to rear. Access to entrance hall.

From the kitchen, access to rear courtyard garden with stone paving and gravel, two shade trees. Access from courtyard garden to outbuilding housing utility room and former aviary/store.

Also from courtyard garden, access to small corridor, WC and back through to entrance hall. Alcove housing central heating boiler, storage. Door through to large vaulted stone storage space, a cellar but at ground level.

Broad, ancient wooden staircase to upper floors. These handsome stairs seem to hold the history of the house.

On an intermediary floor, a large bedroom overlooking the courtyard garden. Access to stone tower.

Further up to an open gallery giving access to:
Bedroom 1, double, overlooking front garden, access to tower

Bedroom 2, double, overlooking front garden
Bathroom with bath, shower over, bidet and wash hand basin, overlooking front garden. Accessible directly from bedrooms 1 and 2, and from gallery.
