DESCRIPTION

This village house sits in the middle of its fenced garden of just over a quarter of an acre. The basement occupies the ground floor of the property creating a handy space for parking a vehicle and for use as a utility room / storage room. The first floor is accessed via external stairs and comprises an entrance hall, a kitchen and lounge of 23m², two bedrooms of 13m² and 11.5m², and a shower room with WC. The property benefits from double glazing, roller shutters and a connection to the mains drains. The attic space is accessed via a further external staircase. With the correct permission, this could be converted to further living space.

There is also a hangar and a small outbuilding in the grounds.

The village of Dournazac is well served with basic amenities and hosts the annual Chestnut festival.

Limoges airport is approximately 38km away which has frequent flights to the UK.
