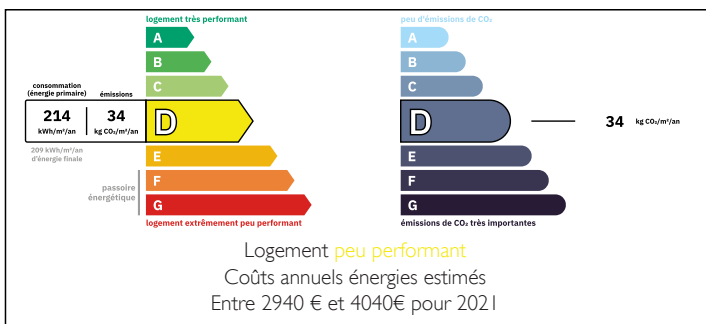
IN BRIEF

DESCRIPTION

This elegant character watermill property with river frontage offers the best of both worlds; historic authenticity from the 17th Century and present-day convenience. Benefiting from gas central heating via a modern boiler and beautiful large open fireplace, the home is fully equipped for comfortable year-round living. The septic fosse conforms.

It's a perfect home sanctuary, the one place in the world where you can feel completely yourself. A ready-to-move-in countryside home in France, or an income-generating gîte property with the option to host guests, retreats, or events in a serene rural environment.

The modern fitted kitchen is bright and functional, with ample storage and a separate utility room providing space for a freezer, washing machine, and fridge. The adjoining dining room exudes French elegance, with a beautiful exposed stone wall and a striking chandelier setting the tone for family dinners or entertaining guests. A convenient WC with washbasin is located just behind the dining area.

The spectacular and spacious family lounge of approximately 52 m² showcases the property's history, with a vaulted ceiling, the millstones exposed and a marble fireplace serving as the centrepiece of the room.
