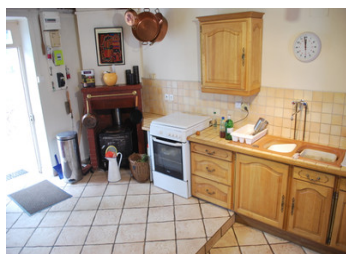

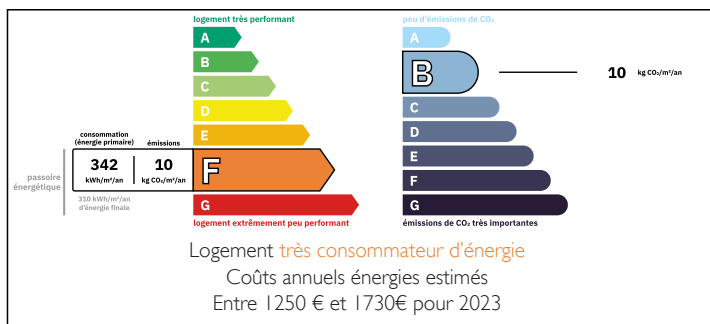

Enter the house into the salon 4.5m x 4m - wood burning stove
Door to kitchen / dining room 6.1m x 4m with wood burning stove - door to garden
Utility room 2.3m x 1.4m with a shower room at the end 1.5m x 1.8m
Stairs to first floor from kitchen
Bedroom 1 - 3m x 5.8m
Bedroom 2 - 3.9m x 3.1m
Bathroom 2.6m x 3.2m

Outside there is a double gate to allow off street parking
A large workshop which used to be where the shoemaker Jean Matthieu made the Clogs - a wood store

The garden is full of fruit trees and mature shrubs

Heating - wood burning stove
Windows - single glazed
Mains Drains
The owners tell me that the roof was renewed in 2005

The house is situated in a quiet hamlet but is only 17km or 15 minutes from the town of Bellac where you will find supermarkets, bars restaurants, etc etc

The airport at Limoges is 46km - 44 minutes drive
