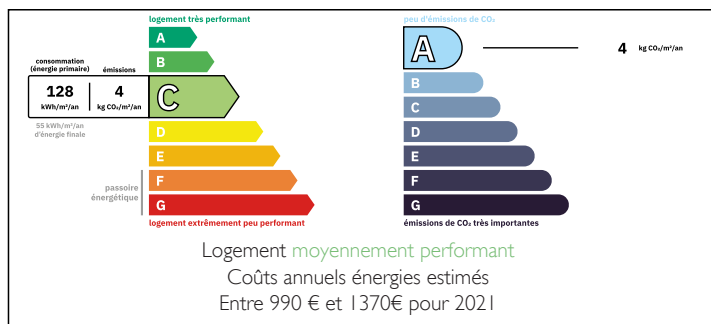

DESCRIPTION

This property sits on an attractive tree-lined square in a lively village with all amenities in walking distance.

The front entrance leads into a spacious front room (23m²) with tiled floor and window looking onto the square. This room could be used as a sitting room or dining area.

The back wall has been opened up with exposed beams and leads through to an open plan kitchen (21m²). From the kitchen, there is access to the garden, several back rooms, and stairs to the first floor.

The rooms at the back of the house are undeveloped and currently comprise of a laundry room (12m²), shower room (3m²) and separate WC.

There are doors to the garden from both the laundry room and kitchen.

The garden is accessed by a side door along the house and opens up to an area of approximately 32m² and a further area behind the neighbouring property with a shed (20m²) and rear entrance.

Wooden stairs lead to the first floor with open plan living room (20m²), WC (2m²), Bedroom 1 (18m²), ensuite shower area (3m²). There is also the opportunity to install a new roof terrace on this floor.

There are further wooden stairs to a mezzanine level floor with Bedroom 2 (16m²) with sloping roof and velux window. There is a separate sink area on this level.
