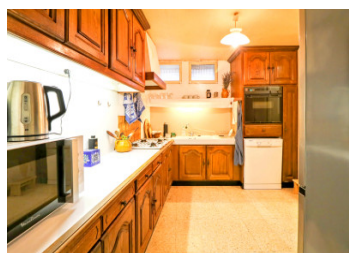
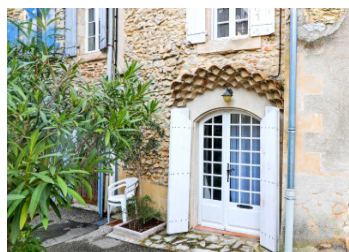


Charming stone village house in 3 levels in centre of mediaeval village Lussan.

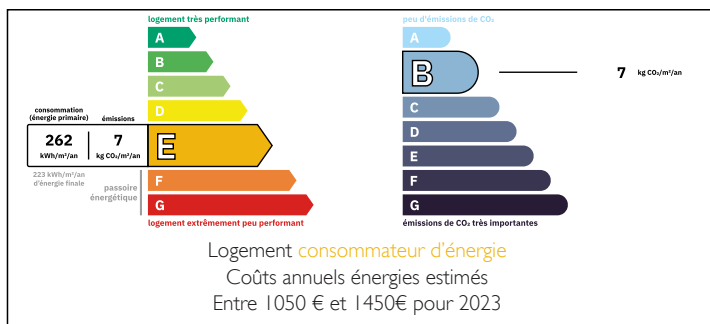
