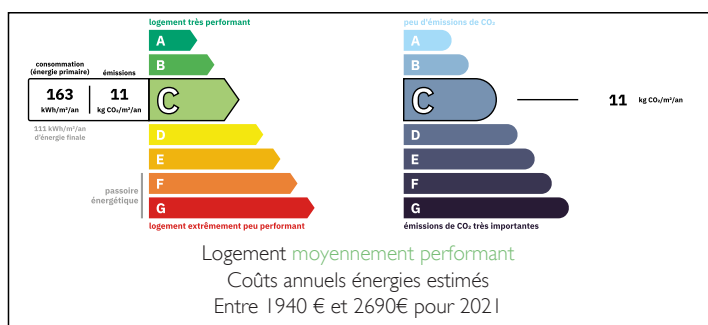

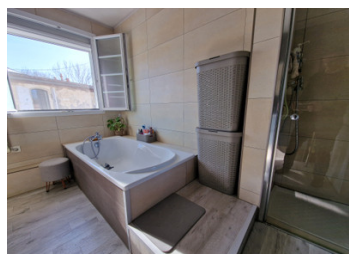

DESCRIPTION

Southwest-facing exposure with a large furnished bright kitchen open onto a 42m² open floorplan living/dining room with authentic original exposed wood beams and classic stone walls, the open-hearth fireplace is just the added touch to make this the warmest of environments.

Upstairs, the large landing is, in fact, another living space lending itself to a lounge, home office, or TV/game room. Two large bedrooms with a separate bathroom (tub, shower, double sink, and toilet) complete this level.

Another loft-style bedroom with adjacent office space upstairs is the perfect complement to the functionality and charm of the property.

The outdoor space which is accessible from the kitchen and living room on the ground floor is dotted with outbuildings for storage, workshops, or an artist's studio, in a lush green setting.

Just a 10-minute walk to the Beautiran train station which offers 15-minute train service to Bordeaux's Gare Saint-Jean on the Metropolitan RER, this property could easily be a second home or a primary residence for commuting into the city.

A village market on Saturdays, hiking trails for miles, and a wonderful community are all waiting for you to discover their charms.
