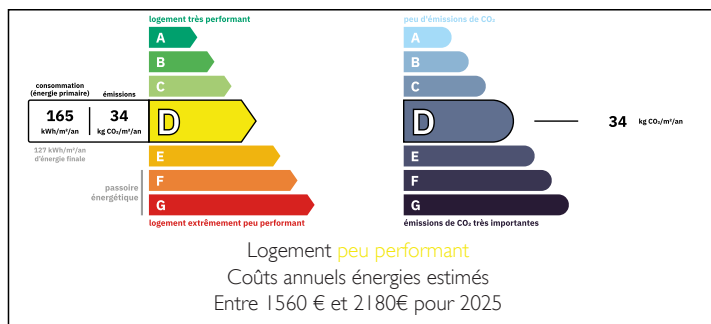
IN BRIEF

With its wrap around garden and far reaching views, this property is an idyllic retreat for anyone seeking tranquility without compromising on convenience

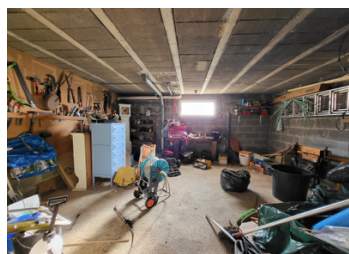

On the interior upon entering the front door you will discover a modern open plan kitchen and sitting room ideal for family living. The layout flows seamlessly into the inner hallway with door leading to the basement, where you will find a workshop space, utility area and car garage. from the hallway you can also access the two downstairs bedrooms, bathroom and separate WC.

from the kitchen there are stairs leading to the first floor double height master bedroom, with dressing room and large shower room with space and plumbing to add a bath.

Double glazed uPVC windows and insulation have been installed throughout by the current owner. the property is heated via a oil fired boiler located in the basement

There are two modern bathrooms, while a separate WC adds an extra layer of convenience for day to day life

Outside, there is the garden space of over 850m2, patio and driveway for several cars.

Located just a short stroll from the vibrant town of Sourdeval, you'll find everything you need at your fingertips—charming bars and restaurants, essential services such as a supermarket, convenience store, pharmacy, and several bakers.
