Authentic Provençal stone house full of charm and character.

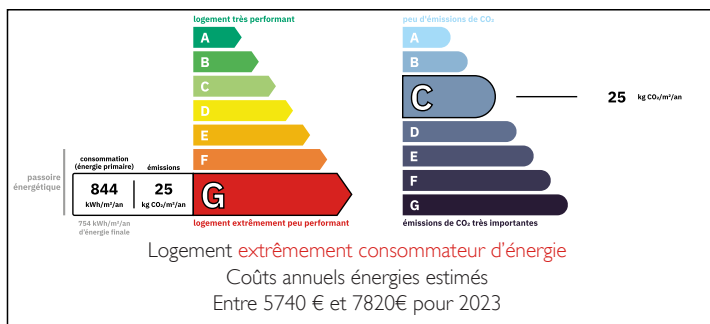
Bathed in southern light, this former relais de poste retains the soul of its past, with a main residence and adjacent stables that once welcomed travelers and horses alike.

There are two entrances at the front of the property and a third at the rear, leading to a 38 m² space still to be converted—perfect for guest projects, ateliers, or independent units.

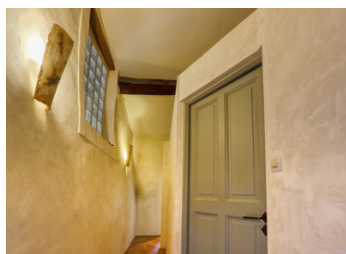
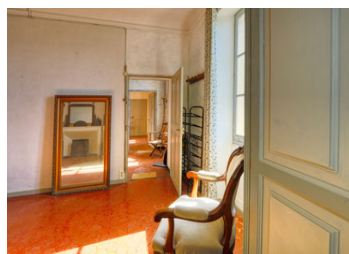
A collection of storied outbuildings includes workshops, stables, and an old bread oven, all set within 1380 m² of land.
