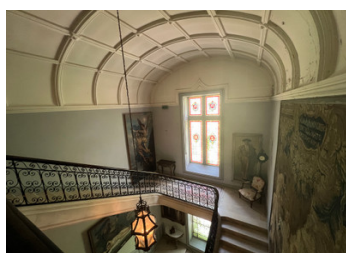
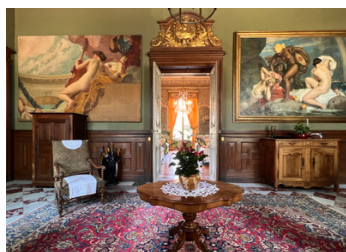


Magnificent 19th-century château with its own private island, swimming pool and tennis court

DESCRIPTION

The château also houses the classified Leroux Collection, an exceptional ensemble of works by the celebrated Leroux family of artists—among them Prix de Rome laureates Auguste and Georges Leroux—adding an important artistic dimension to the estate's architectural and historical significance.

FURNITURE: The château is sold complete with its carefully assembled collection of period furniture, historic tapestries, antique chandeliers and lighting, paintings, oriental carpets and decorative works of art, preserving the elegance and authenticity of its historic interiors.

The numerous outbuildings offer exceptional potential for restoration and adaptation, whether as additional guest accommodation, leisure facilities, workshops or other projects inspired by the future owner's vision.
