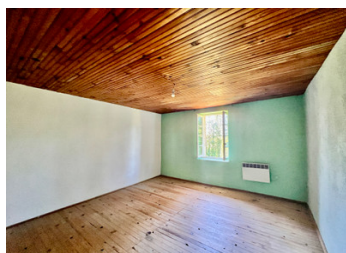

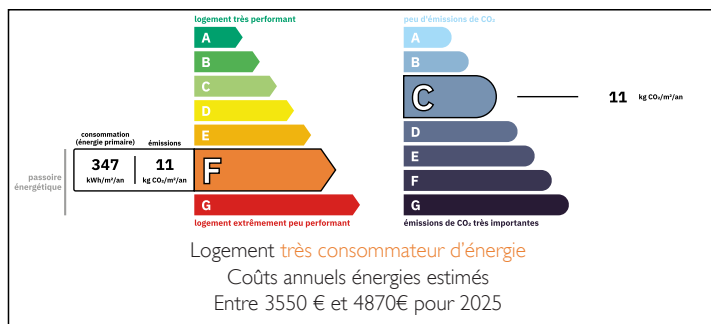

Tucked back from a quiet lane in a peaceful hamlet, this character-filled 3-bedroom stone property welcomes you into a cosy salon, 23m², with exposed beams and a traditional stone fireplace. The adjoining dining room, 23.77m², includes hatch access to the cellar—perfect for storage or wine. The spacious kitchen, 34.58m² ready to be fitted to your taste, already features a charming wood burner, fireplace surround, and a sink unit. From here, step out onto the terrace overlooking lovely garden views—ideal for alfresco dining or peaceful evenings outdoors. With exposed stone walls, beamed ceilings, a beautiful stone staircase, and an attached barn, 65m², offering great potential, this already habitable home is bursting with original charm.

Upstairs are three bedrooms: 16m², 18.51m², 40m², two with charming garden views, and a very large third room that could easily be divided or transformed into a spacious master suite.

There is also a shower room, 3m², with WC, completely functionable. Above, the attic space could be transformed into a studio, hobby room, or more, subject to the necessary permissions. Full of original features and possibilities.

Outside, the attached barn—with a renewed roof in 2015—offers a great workshop or further development space. The beautifully maintained gardens feature mature trees creating dappled shade throughout—a perfect countryside escape with plenty of scope to make it your own.
