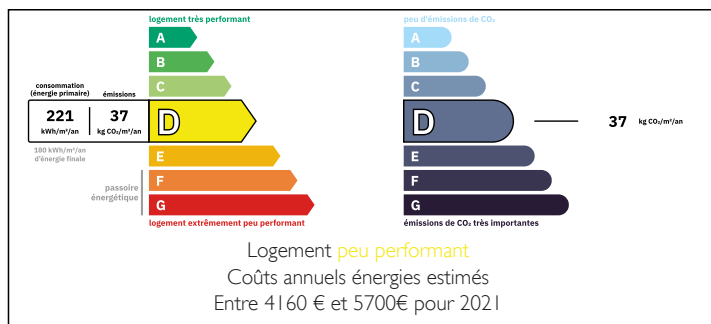
IN BRIEF

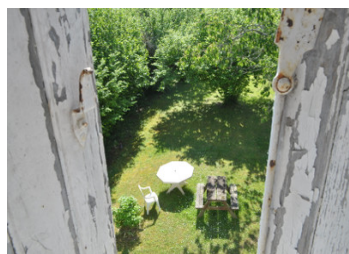

DESCRIPTION

The house. On the ground floor: Entrance hall (17.4m²), spacious fully equipped kitchen-diner (24.30m²) with wooden floor and woodstove. Utility room (5.6 m²), bedroom (27m²), bathroom and toilet (4.38m²).

A wide staircase sweeps you up to the first floor: landing 19.58m², a light lounge with Périgourdin parquet 27.45m²; a second lounge at the back of the house 32m² equipped with a fireplace.

Second floor: landing (5.65m²), two bedrooms (28m²; 14.33m²;) the large bedroom is furnished with a wood stove and has a wooden floor; the second bedroom has an open beamed ceiling; office (5.88m²); bathroom and toilet (6m²); large walk-in storage cupboard (3.31m²).

The house is heated by oil-fired central heating and is well -insulated. Mains drainage.

There is a delightful terrace at the back of the house in front of the barn 18m² for entertaining your guests.

Outbuildings: Large, stone barn: 84.41m². There are two wine cellars under the house: 118m² and 15.72m². There is also an old servants' house in need of renovation at the back of the property. Large garden with lawns. and a dovecote.
