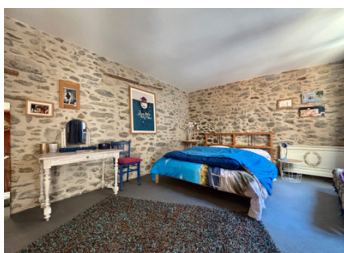

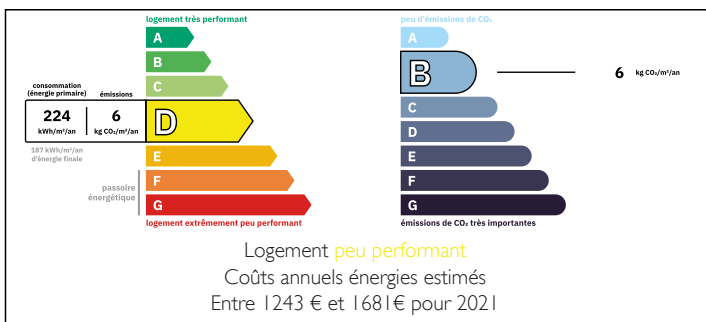

DESCRIPTION

As you enter the property, you're welcomed by a bright and inviting dining area with an open-plan kitchen. French doors lead out to a tranquil central courtyard with stone paving—an ideal spot for dining or relaxing in the shade. A lovely arched stone opening provides access to a characterful cellar or storage area, perfect for wine or garden tools.

From the dining area, a few steps lead you into a cosy living room adorned with original terracotta flooring and a charming wood-burning stove. This comfortable space also opens onto a second, more private courtyard filled with mature Mediterranean plants—an oasis of calm and greenery.

The first floor offers three well-proportioned bedrooms, each with its own unique outlook—one over the leafy rear courtyard and another facing the central one. A spacious family bathroom and a separate WC complete this level.

The top floor is a true highlight of the property: a bright and versatile 30m² room currently used as a home office but easily transformed into the fourth bedroom, studio, or hobby room. From here, step out onto the spectacular roof terrace, partly covered for year-round enjoyment. With plenty of space for lounging, dining, it offers views and sunshine from morning to evening.

This is a rare opportunity to own a fully modernised stone home with authentic character and exceptional outdoor living in one of the region's most charming villages.
