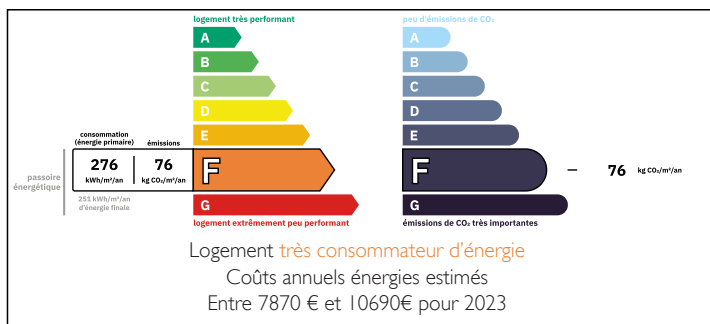

DESCRIPTION

The original stone building was originally a farm and stables, built around 1850, with a later extension around 1940, now offering spacious character filled rooms. Entrance to the front with large stone hallway with stone fireplace (now used as office), through to fabulous living room with beautiful stone wall featuring the Lot et Garonne stone and brick, also open fire and feature full height chimney, a stunning room, opening out onto rear gardens and swimming pool and terraces. Kitchen with fitted units and breakfast space, door to gardens, utility room with fitted cupboards, swimming pool room with new pump and filter and pipework for the salt water pool, bathroom with bath, shower WC and wash basins. Large bedroom with stone walls and beamed ceiling, second large square bedroom, newly fitted bathroom with bath and shower WC and wash basin, another large square room with arched windows and fireplace used as library and billiard room, leading into bright bedroom with dual aspect arched windows, with garden views. Large covered terrace onto pool for your apéros! There is also a large garage/barn with a mezzanine level, used as a wood store. and for the oil central heating boiler and oil tank. The mezzanine would convert.

Large private fully enclosed gardens to all sides, to the front there are lawns and a forest of trees, a copse of poplars, some lovely old oak trees to the front of the house with a stone...
