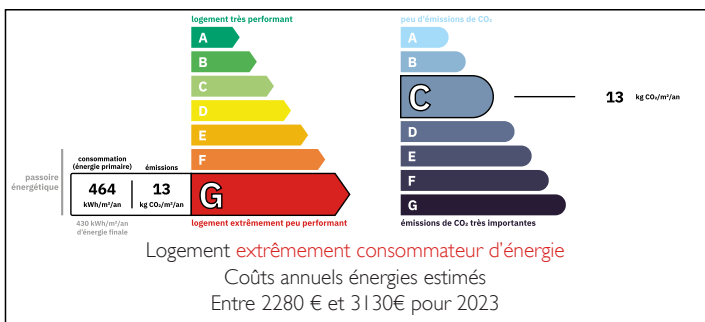

This delightful holiday cottage is located at the end of a quiet lane in a peaceful hamlet, boasting breath-taking views. The living space, predominantly on one level with a few small steps between rooms, includes:

Kitchen/Breakfast Room (17.56 m²) featuring a tiled floor, a glazed door opening onto the terrace, and a charming original stone sink.

Dining Room (22.45 m²) with terracotta flooring and exposed beams.

Bathroom (4 m²) with a bath, handbasin, and toilet.

Sitting Room (26 m²) with terracotta floors, exposed stone walls, and wooden beams, complemented by a stunning fireplace with a wood-burning stove. A glazed door leads outside.

Master Bedroom (24 m²) – a spacious room with an en-suite bathroom and terracotta flooring.

En-suite Shower Room (3.21 m²) with a shower, handbasin, and toilet.

Guest Bedroom (22.5 m²) with terracotta flooring.

Outside: A tiled terrace just outside the kitchen offers a lovely spot to sit and unwind.

At the rear of the house, there's parking for one car, along with a stone outbuilding/workshop (22 m²).
