In the heart of a small village with an extraordinary 12th-century fortified church, facing it, the house has all the basics for a tasteful renovation.

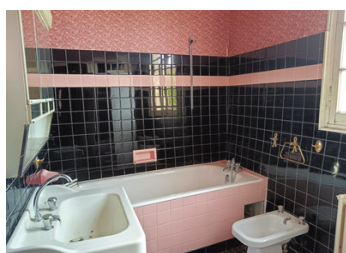
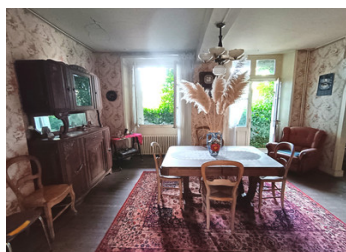

The house has oil-fired central heating and is connected to mains drainage.

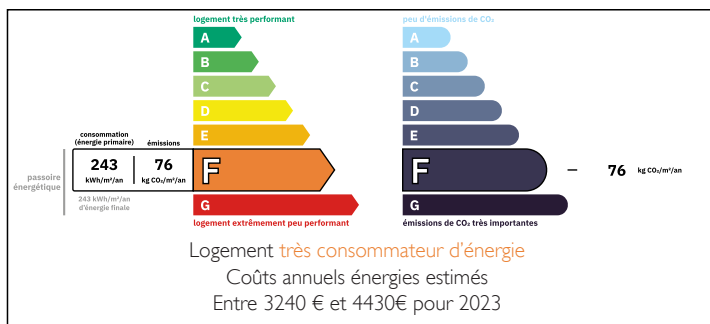

DESCRIPTION

In 'its original condition', this is a wonderful opportunity to purchase a group of properties at a low price, either to renovate or completely restore, located in a charming and very photogenic village in the Val de Dronne.

The first property to renovate, with a surface area of approximately 80 m², comprises an entrance hall, a kitchen and a living room.

A beautiful traditional elm staircase leads to the upper floor.

Bathroom. Toilet. Storage room.

Two beautiful bedrooms, each measuring over 13 m², offer unrivalled views of the impressive stone structure that is the extraordinary medieval church of Grand-Brassac.

Construction of this fortified church began around 1140 and was completed in the 13th century. Attacked several times during the Hundred Years' War and then during the Wars of Religion, it served as a refuge for the inhabitants without ever falling into enemy hands. (Wikipedia)

The house is built on a cellar with double access, including level access from the inner courtyard.

A second, very old house adjoins the main dwelling. Two rooms were once converted and form the basis of a total restoration project including another part of the building to be preserved.

Adjacent to the buildings is a 340 m² plot of land planted with fruit trees (cherry, apple, etc.) on the outskirts of the village, 200 metres from the house.
