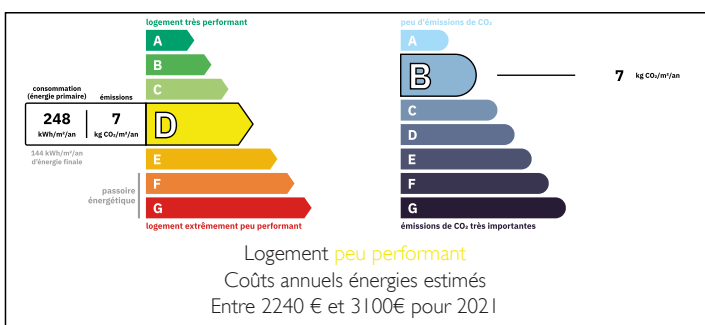

DESCRIPTION

Just a few steps from the village square and the historic château, this charming property offers an exceptional riverside lifestyle in one of the Dordogne's prettiest villages.

You enter the home through a welcoming hallway that leads into the 18m² kitchen, complete with fully fitted units, exposed stone walls, and a beamed ceiling, blending modern comfort with rustic charm. A separate utility room with WC and washbasin provides added practicality.

From the kitchen, a door opens into the dining room, featuring a beamed ceiling and fireplace with inset log burner. This space connects beautifully with the outdoors, with doors opening directly onto the balcony overlooking the riverbank and double doors to the left lead to a large covered terrace—perfect for riverside dining and entertaining.

Another door from the kitchen leads into the summer lounge, which also has a wood-burning stove and double patio doors that open directly onto the 40m² covered terrace, offering uninterrupted views of the river and the cascading weir.

Beyond the terrace is a large parking area and garden shed with stone steps leading down to the private canoe mooring—ideal for river access and quiet contemplation.

Upstairs, a lovely first-floor lounge area features a balcony overlooking the river, creating a peaceful retreat plus an additional fireplace. From here, you'll find a double bedroom with its own shower and washbasin, a master bedroom with another riverside balcony, and a family bathroom with bath, shower, washbasin, and WC.

A further staircase leads to the third bedroom, a bright and spacious 30m²...
