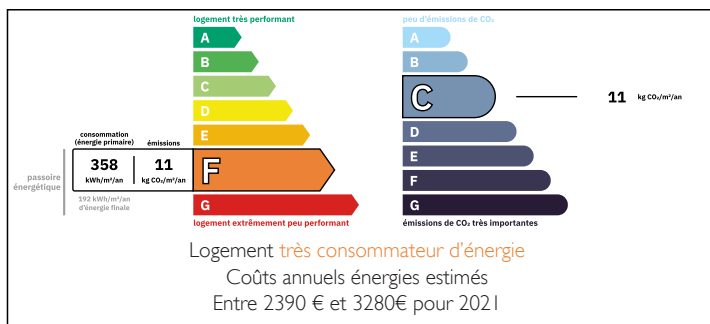

The property comprises of:

Large front garden with parking for several cars. Front door into lounge /diner with tiled floor and wood burning stove. Windows to back and front. Off of here is a kitchen and a W.C/shower room. Running along the entire back of the house is a covered verandah where you can reach the cool storage room.

Upstairs on 1st floor is a master bedroom with windows to front and its own bathroom with bath shower and W.C.

Up another short flight of steps and you come to the other 3 bedrooms, one of which could easily become a bathroom /W.C to furnish these rooms. Attached to the house is a workshop/laundry area and then, a good size barn suitable for the car etc and still more room after that on another two levels. The established back garden has got good countryside views.

The lovely village of Crozant is nearby with its gorge and medieval ruins as is Fresselines, once the home of Monet the artist. The surrounding countryside provided lots of his inspiration. Also near to leisure lakes, equestrian centres, cycle routes and river swimming. Plenty to do.

You are near to the little market town of Dun Le Palestel 7.5 kms and approximately 23 kms to the larger town of La Souterraine with its choice of supermarkets and train station with a high speed link to Paris. Limoges with its airport is approx 78 kms. A lovely property in a good location..
