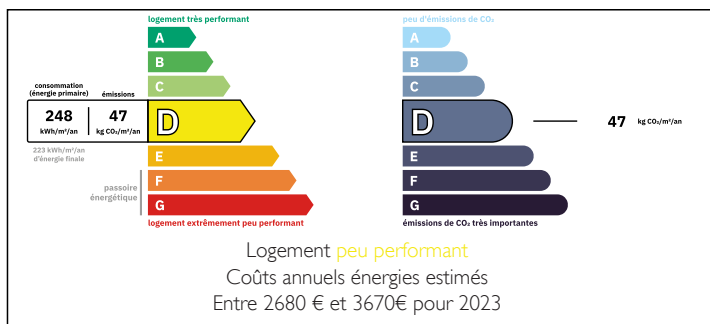
IN BRIEF
